## 9/11 Memorial

Did you know:

Rosemead is rated 5th top out of 22 of the most powerful 9/11 memorials around the World, according to BuzzFed.com. I

purchased a brick at the base of the memorial indicating T.H.O.S.E. – “The Hero's Of September Eleventh.”

Heath Satow's sculpture "Reflect" is made with a damaged, rusted L-beam from the collapsed World Trade Center buildings.

Each of the two giant hands are constructed with 2,976 interlocking birds welded together to create hands lifting a twisted steel beam from New York's World Trade Center depicting each life lost in the 2001 attacks.

Every September 11th, Memorial Services are held 6-8 p.m. at the City Hall, in front of the 9/11 Memorial.
